GIFT AID DECLARATION NOTES

1. Every £1 contributed by a taxpayer is worth £1.28 to the Trust which can claim 28p from HM Customs and Revenue.
2. However, in order that the Trust can make such a repayment claim, your liability to Income or Capital Gains Tax for the tax year in which the relevant payment is made must equal or exceed the amount of tax which the Trust will reclaim in respect of your payment.
3. If you are a higher rate taxpayer you can claim further relief for your Gift Aid payments in your self-assessment tax return.
4. If the condition in 2 above is at any time in the future not met, please promptly notify the Trust.
5. You may at any time by notice to the Trust cancel your Declaration as to payments to be made on or after the date of cancellation. Separate notice to your bank will be required, however, to cancel any standing order payments.
