

The Joyful Company of Singers: Garlands for Two Elizabeths

Our successful series of fundraising concerts for the Endellion Appeal continues this year, notably with a visit on the first weekend in May by the Joyful Company of Singers, one of the country's foremost chamber choirs, which enjoyed a long association with the late Richard Hickox.



In honour of the Queen's diamond jubilee, they will perform a programme blending works from *A Garland for the Queen*, commissioned to celebrate her coronation with a selection from Morley's *The Triumphs of Oriana*, in celebration of her illustrious predecessor, Elizabeth I. All the 1950s songs are well worth a place in the repertoire, and to hear them in conjunction with the music of an earlier age reminds one of the marvellous heritage of choral writing this country enjoys.

The Joyful Company's first performance will be at St Endellion Church on Saturday May 5th, their second, the following evening at St Mary's Penzance. Both concerts start at 7.30pm. Unreserved tickets at £10 will be available through the Hall for Cornwall's website and box office, from the Wadebridge Bookshop and on the door of either church on the night. They will also be on sale during the Easter Festival.
